TAX (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1965.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Tax Ordinance.

[19th February, 1966]

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1966.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1965, and shall be construed and read as one with the Tax Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of a colon for the full stop at the end of the proviso and the addition thereto of the following proviso —

“Provided further that the duty chargeable as aforesaid shall be remitted if the matches are taken out of bond or purchased for the use of Her Majesty’s Armed Forces stationed in British Guiana.”
