AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pilgrim Holiness Church Ordinance.

[19th February, 1966]

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

A.D. 1966.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pilgrim Holiness Church (Amendment) Ordinance, 1965 and shall be construed and read as one with the Pilgrim Holiness Church Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title.

Cap. 224.

2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "Secretary of World Missions" for the words "General Missionary Superintendent" wherever they occur.

Amendment of Chapter 224.

3. Any reference to the General Missionary Superintendent in any other enactment, instrument or document of any kind shall be construed as a reference to the Secretary of World Missions.

Consequential changes.

4. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be deemed to affect any right of Her Majesty the Queen, Her Heirs and Successors, or of any body politic or corporate or of any other person or persons except such as are mentioned in this Ordinance and those claiming by, from, through or under them.

Saving the rights of Her Majesty.

Passed by the House of Assembly on the 23rd of December, 1965.
