AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pensions (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1957.

[19th February, 1966]

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1966.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions (Consolidation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1966, and shall be construed and read as one with the Pensions (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1957, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

2. (1) Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended in the following respects —

Amendment of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance

(a) by the insertion immediately before the definition of the expression “pensionable office”, of the following definition —

“inducement allowance” means the inducement allowance referred to in paragraph (a) of clause 3 of the schedule to the Overseas Service Agreement Ordinance, 1961; ’; and

(b) by the substitution of the following paragraph for paragraph (a) of the definition of the expression “pensionable emoluments” —

“(a) in respect of service in British Guiana include—

- (i) salary;
- (ii) personal allowance; and

- (iii) such portion of the inducement allowance as the Government of the United Kingdom and the Government of British Guiana may, from time to time, by agreement determine to be pensionable,

but do not include any duty or entertainment allowance or any other emoluments whatever;”.

(2) Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of this section shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st April, 1961, and paragraph (b) of the said subsection shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1964.

3. Regulation 2 of the Pensions Regulations, 1957 (as amended by the Pensions (Consolidation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963) is hereby further amended in the following respects —

- (a) by renumbering the regulation as paragraph (1); and
(b) by the insertion of the following paragraph as paragraph (2) —

“(2) For the purpose of these Regulations —

- (a) any officer in public service under the Government of the Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland immediately before the 1st January, 1964, who was immediately before that date employed on secondment to service under the Government of Southern Rhodesia, or Northern Rhodesia or Nyasaland, or was as from that date so employed, shall be deemed to continue to serve in public service under the Government of the Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland until his employment on secondment is terminated;
- (b) any pension awarded on or after the 1st January, 1964, in respect of service under the Government of the Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland shall be deemed to have been granted by that Government notwithstanding the provisions of The Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland (Dissolution) Order in Council, 1963.”
