Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana :—

A.D. 1967

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Miscellaneous Enactments (Amendment) Act, 1967, and so far as it amends any Ordinance shall be construed and read as one with that Ordinance and all amendments thereto.

Short title and commencement.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation in respect of item 3 of the schedule hereto at the commencement of the Official Designations Ordinance.

2. The enactments specified in the first column of the schedule to this Act shall be amended to the extent set out in the second column thereof.
