CONSTITUTION (PRESCRIBED MATTERS) ACT, 1967.

Arrangement of Sections.

Section

- 1. Short title.
- 2. Age for vacation of office by the holders of certain offices.

AN ACT to prescribe the age for the vacation of office by the holders of certain offices as authorised by the Constitution of Guyana.

[20th September, 1967]

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

A.D. 1967.

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Prescribed Matters) Act, 1967.

Short title.

2. The Director of Audit and the Commissioner of Police shall vacate their respective offices on attaining the age of fifty-five years:

Age for vacation of office by the holders of certain offices.

Provided that —

- (i) the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Public Service Commission, may permit a Director of Audit who has attained the age of fifty-five years to continue in office until he has attained such later age, not exceeding sixty years, as may (before the Director of Audit has attained the age of fifty-five years) have been agreed with the Director;

- (ii) the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Police Service Commission tendered after the Prime Minister has concurred in that recommendation, may permit a Commissioner of Police who has attained the age of fifty-five years to continue in office until he has attained such later age, not exceeding sixty years, as may (before the Commissioner of Police has attained the age of fifty-five years) have been agreed with the Commissioner of Police.
