AN ACT to amend the Industries Aid and Encouragement Ordinance.

[30th December, 1967]

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

A.D. 1967.

1. This Act may be cited as the Industries Aid and Encouragement (Amendment) Act, 1967, and shall be construed and read as one with the Industries Aid and Encouragement Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and all amendments thereto. Short title.  
Cap 109.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following definition — Amendment of  
section 2 of  
the Principal  
Ordinance.

‘“Minister” means the Minister responsible for finance.’

3. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the proviso thereto of the following — Amendment of  
section 6 of  
the Principal  
Ordinance.

“Provided that this section shall not apply to items imported as replacements or renewals of any existing machinery, plant or appliances or for the purpose of rehabilitation of existing machinery, plant or equipment.”

section 7 of

Ordinance.

4. (1) Paragraph (b) of section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the word “five” for the word “three”.

(2) Such amendment shall not have effect in relation to goods entered as mentioned in paragraph (b) aforesaid prior to the date of the coming into operation of this subsection.

5. (1) The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the word “Minister” for the words “Governor in Council” wherever they appear.

(2) Anything lawfully done under the Principal Ordinance prior to its amendment by subsection (1) of this section, and which would continue to have effect but for such amendment, shall continue to have effect as if so done in conformity with such amendment.
