AN ACT to make special provision with respect to the pensionable service of Doctors Thomas Reginald Jones and Ovid Ashworth Hercules Johnson.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

A.D. 1968.

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions (Special Provision) Act, 1968. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary provided by any Ordinance in that behalf, in computing the amount of pension or gratuity payable to any of the public officers named in the first column of the schedule to this Act, the period mentioned in the second column of the said schedule in relation to any such officer shall be taken into account as a period of pensionable service.
