AN ACT to amend the Roads Ordinance.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title.
Cap. 277.

1. This Act may be cited as the Roads (Amendment) Act, 1968, and shall be read and construed as one with the Roads Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and all amendments thereto.

Amendment
of section 6
of Principal
Ordinance.

2. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion after subsection (1) of the following subsection —

“(1A) The management of the roads which is entrusted under subsection (1) of this section shall include authority to cause to be collected such charges for the passage of vehicles on a road, at such places, as may be prescribed by regulations made under section 25 of this Ordinance; and on a road, at any such place, there may be apparatus, barriers and other erections constructed or maintained under such authority.”

Amendment
of section 26
of Principal
Ordinance.

3. Section 26 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words “twenty-four dollars”, at the end of subsection (1), of the words “two hundred and fifty dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to both such penalty and imprisonment”.
