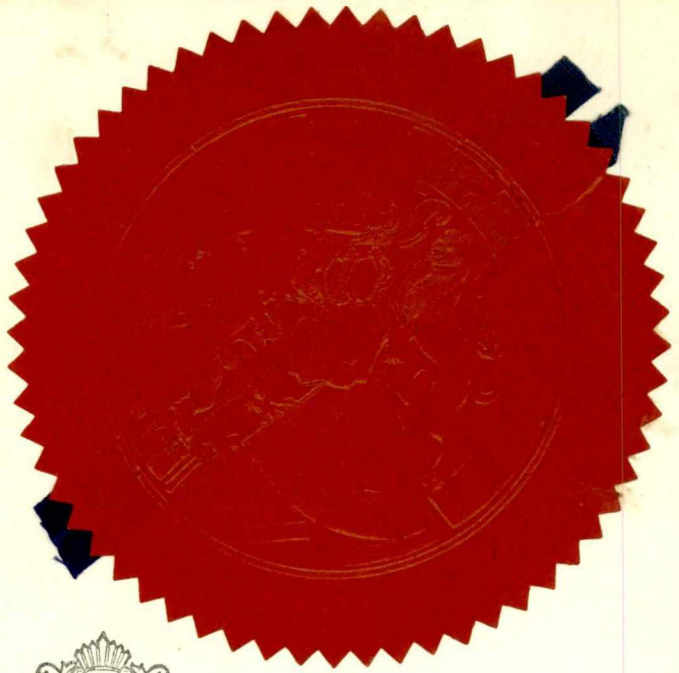

Arrangement of Sections.

Section

1. Short title.
2. Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorised.
3. Appropriations Schedule.

SCHEDULE.

AN ACT to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the year ending 31st December, 1970, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for appropriation of that sum for specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution of Guyana.

A.D. 1970 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1970.

Issue from
the Consoli-
dated Fund
authorised.

2. The Accountant General may, on the warrant of the Minister, issue from the Consolidated Fund a sum not exceeding in the aggregate the gross amount of one hundred and seventy-seven million, one hundred and forty-nine thousand, eight hundred and fifty-six dollars for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Government and for other purposes for the financial year ending on the 31st December, 1970, and before that date the appropriate Accounting Officers shall pay in to the Accountant General for deposit into the Consolidated Fund, the sums totalling three million, seven hundred and one thousand, seven hundred and ninety-eight dollars shown as appropriations-in-aid in the last column of the schedule to this Act, thereby making the issues from the Consolidated Fund to meet expenditure for the financial year, not exceeding in the aggregate the net sum of one hundred and seventy-three million, four hundred and forty-eight thousand, and fifty-eight dollars.

3. The net sum granted in section 2 of this Act is hereby appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the schedule to this Act pursuant to and in accordance with paragraph (2) of Article 111 of the Constitution of Guyana and shall be deemed to have been so authorised from 1st day of January, 1970.

SCHEDULE

Schedule of :—

- (a) the net sum granted; and
- (b) sums which may be applied as appropriations-in-aid in addition thereto,

to defray the charges of the several Heads of Expenditure herein particularly mentioned which will come in course of payment during the year ending 31st December, 1970.
