AN ACT to effect a modification to section 46 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) Ordinance for certain purposes.

A.D. 1971. Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) (Modification) Act, 1971.

Modification of section 46 of Chapter 12.

Cap. 186.

- 2. So long as this Act is in force, section 46 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) Ordinance shall have effect in relation to the hearing and determination of an application made pursuant to section 6 of the Rent Control Ordinance as if for subsection (2) of the said section 46 (other than the proviso thereto) there had been substituted the following
 - "(2) Nothing in this section shall prevent a magistrate from sitting
 - (a) before nine o'clock in the morning with the consent of the parties or their counsel or solicitor;
 - (b) after four o'clock in the afternoon until nine o'clock in the evening without such consent;
 - (c) after nine o'clock in the evening with such consent:".

Duration of Act.

3. The President may, by order, declare that this Act shall cease to be in force on a date to be specified in the order.
