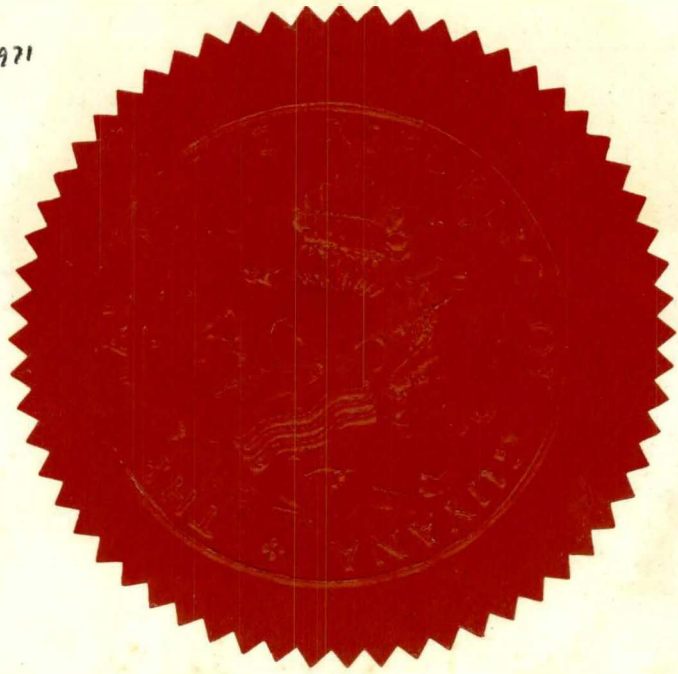

**TOWN OF CHRISTIANBURG/WISMAR/MACKENZIE
(CHANGE OF NAME) ACT, 1971.**

1. Short title.
2. Change in the name of the Town of Christianburg/Wis-
mar/Mackenzie.

AN ACT to effect a change in the name of the Town of Christianburg/Wismar/Mackenzie and in the Town Council of the Town.

A.D. 1971 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Town of Christianburg/Wismar/Mackenzie (Change of Name) Act, 1971.

Change in the name of the Town of Christianburg/Wismar/Mackenzie. No. 24 of 1969.

2. (1) Anything in section 33 of the Municipal and District Councils Act, 1969, to the contrary notwithstanding, as from 6th March, 1971, the Town of Christianburg/Wismar/Mackenzie and The Mayor and Town of Christianburg/Wismar/Mackenzie shall be deemed to have been renamed as the Town of Linden, and The Mayor and Town Council of Linden, respectively.

(2) Every law, instrument or document of any kind, having effect on or after 6th March, 1971, which makes reference to the Town of Christianburg/Wismar/Mackenzie or to The Mayor and Town Council of Christianburg/Wismar/Mackenzie shall, if it continues to have effect after that date, be construed in relation to any time after 5th March, 1971, as if for every such reference to the said Town of Christianburg/Wismar/Mackenzie or to The Mayor and Town Council of Christianburg/Wismar/Mackenzie there had been substituted a reference to The Town of Linden, or The Mayor and Town Council of Linden, respectively.

(3) The change of name effected by virtue of subsection (1) shall not affect any rights or obligations of the Town Council or render defective any legal proceedings by or against the Town Council, and any legal proceedings that might have been continued or commenced against the Town Council by its former name may be continued or commenced against it by its new name.
