



# GUYANA

## ACT NO. 14 OF 1972 APPROPRIATION ACT 1972

### Arrangement of Sections

**Section**

- 1. Short title.
- 2. Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorised.
- 3. Appropriations Schedule.

An Act to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the financial year ending 31st December, 1973, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for appropriation of that sum for specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution.

Short title

Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorised.

Appropriations Schedule

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1972.
2. The Accountant General, may on the warrant of the Minister, issue from the Consolidated Fund a sum not exceeding in the aggregate the gross amount of two hundred and eighty-two million, two hundred and ninety-one thousand, and eighty-three dollars for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Government and for other purposes for the financial year ending on the 31st December, 1973, and before that date the appropriate accounting officers shall pay in to the Accountant General for deposit into the Consolidated Fund, the sums totalling four million, five hundred and fifty-seven thousand, four hundred and ninety-eight dollars shown as appropriations-in-aid in the last column of the schedule, thereby making the issues from the Consolidated Fund to meet expenditure for the financial year, not exceeding in the aggregate the net sum of two hundred and seventy-seven million, seven hundred and thirty-three thousand, five hundred and eighty-five dollars.
3. The net sum granted in section 2 is hereby appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the schedule pursuant to and in accordance with Article 111(2) of the Constitution with effect from 1st January, 1973.

- (a) the net sum granted; and
- (b) sums which may be applied as appropriations-in-aid in addition thereto.
