AN ACT to amend The Gambling Prevention Ordinance.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Gambling Prevention (Amendment) Act, 1969, and shall be construed and read as one with the Gambling Prevention Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and all amendments thereto.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion immediately before the definition of "place" of the following definition—

"Minister" means the Minister to whom responsibility for matters relating to gambling prevention has been assigned;

3. Section 20 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "or such greater sum as the Minister in any particular case deems meet" immediately after the word "dollars".

4. (1) Wherever in the Principal Ordinance the expression "Governor and Legislative Council" or "Governor in Council" appears, there shall be substituted therefor the word "Minister".

(2) Anything lawfully done under the Principal Ordinance prior to its amendment by subsection (1) of this section, and which would continue to have effect but for such amendment, shall continue to have effect as if so done in conformity with such amendment.
