ORDINANCE No. 6 of 1949.

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the payment of a reduced Pension and Gratuity to certain non-Commissioned Officers and Constables of the Police Force.

[26th. March, 1949.]

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:— A.D. 1949.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Constabulary (Special Provisions) (Pensions) Ordinance, 1949. Short title

2. Anything contained in any Ordinance to the contrary notwithstanding, the provisions of subsections (1) and (2) of section eighty-three of the Constabulary Ordinance, as amended from time to time, shall apply to any non-commissioned officer or constable enrolled in the police force on or before the twenty-sixth day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, who on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and forty-eight was a member of the force, and who, on or before the first day of July, nineteen hundred and forty-nine gives notice in writing to the Commissioner of Police that he desires the provisions of this Ordinance to apply to him.
