ORDINANCE No. 15 OF 1949.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Civil List Ordinance by A.D. 1949. increasing the amount which shall be payable to His Majesty for defraying the expenses of certain services. —

[1st October, 1949.]

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Civil List (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be construed with the Civil List Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title. Cap. 52.

2. Section two of the Principal Ordinance as amended from time to time is hereby further amended by the substitution for the words "twenty-nine thousand one hundred and fifty", of the words "thirty-seven thousand six hundred". Amendment of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance

Amendment of section 4 of the Principal Ordinance.

3. Section four of the Principal Ordinance as amended from time to time is hereby further amended by the substitution for the words "twenty-nine thousand one hundred and fifty" of the words "thirty-seven thousand six hundred".

Substitution of new Schedule to the Principal Ordinance. No. 35 of 1944.

4. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance as substituted by section four of the Civil List (Amendment) Ordinance, 1944, is hereby repealed and the following Schedule substituted therefor—

6. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and forty-nine.
