ORDINANCE No. 16 OF 1949.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Supreme Court of Judicature Ordinance by increasing the salaries payable to the Chief Justice and the Puisne Judges. A.D. 1949.

[ 1st October, 1949. ]

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supreme Court of Judicature (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be construed with the Supreme Court of Judicature Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short

2. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended — Amend-

(a) by the substitution in subsection (1) for the words “four thousand five hundred and fifty” and for the words “twenty-one thousand eight hundred and forty”, of the words “five thousand three hundred” and the words “twenty-five thousand four hundred and forty” respectively.

(b) by the substitution for the words “eighteen hundred”, “fifteen hundred” and “twelve hundred and fifty” in subsection (2) of the words “two thousand one hundred”, “seventeen hundred”, and “fifteen hundred” respectively.

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and forty-nine. Com-
