ORDINANCE No. 18 OF 1949.

AN ORDINANCE to provide that the Minimum Wages (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Watchmen) Order, 1949, shall become effective on the first day of January nineteen hundred and forty-nine. A.D. 1949.

[1st October, 1949.]

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Watchmen) Order (Validation) Ordinance, 1949. Short title.

2. Anything to the contrary contained in subsection five of section eight of the Labour Ordinance, 1942, notwithstanding, the provisions of the Minimum Wages (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Watchmen) Order, 1949, shall be deemed to have become effective on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and forty-nine.
