ORDINANCE No. 24 OF 1949.

AD. 1949

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance by increasing the fees and poundage money payable in respect of strays within the city of Georgetown.

[5th November, 1949.]

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Town Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be construed with the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion therein after section two hundred of the following section—

“Fees and poundage money where stray is impounded in the city.

200A. Where any animal has been impounded under the provisions of the last preceding section, section four and subsection (1) of section five of the Pounds Ordinance shall have effect as if there were substituted for the words “forty-eight cents” and “thirty-two cents” the words “two dollars”, and for the words “twenty-four cents” the words “one dollar”.”
