ORDINANCE No. 27 OF 1949.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Widows and Orphans A.D. 1949. Pension Ordinance by making provision for the increase of pensions as registered on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-eight.

[24th December, 1949]

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Widows and Orphans Short title. Pension (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be construed with the Widows and Orphans Pension Ordinance, hereinafter Cap. 207. referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Anything contained in the Principal Ordinance to the contrary notwithstanding, the pensions which were registered on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-eight, as payable under the Principal Ordinance, or any Ordinance amending the same, to the widows or children of officers in the event of their death after the date aforesaid, shall be increased by sixty *per centum*.
