ORDINANCE No. 31 OF 1949.

AN ORDINANCE to continue in operation for a further period of one year The Sugar Duty Ordinance, 1942. A.D. 1949.

[31st December, 1949.]

WHEREAS the Sugar Duty Ordinance, 1942, which was temporary in its duration and limited to expire on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-two, was continued in operation from year to year to the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-nine;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient further to extend the operation of the said Ordinance;

BE IT THEREFORE, enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sugar Duty (Continuance) Ordinance, 1949. Short Title.

2. The Sugar Duty Ordinance, 1942, shall continue in operation until and including the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty. Continuance until 31st December, 1950, of Ordinance No. 11 of 1942
