## ORDINANCE No. 1 OF 1950.

An Ordinance to appropriate the supplies granted in the cur- A.D. 1950 rent session of the Legislative Council.

[25th March, 1950.

WHEREAS of the amount of twenty-two million one hundred and ninety-one thousand five hundred and fifty-three dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of this Colony, and for other purposes, for the year commencing on the first day of January nineteen hundred and fifty, the sum of one million seven hundred and seventy-four thousand five hundred and sixty-six dollars has been provided for by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of the Colony of twenty million four hundred and sixteen thousand nine hundred and eighty-seven dollars:

Be it, therefore, enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1950.

Financial Secretary and Treasurer to defray expenses of Civil Government. 2. The Financial Secretary and Treasurer shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay from the annual revenue of the year, commencing the first day of January nineteen hundred and fifty and other resources of the Colony a sum not exceeding in the aggregate twenty million four hundred and sixteen thousand nine hundred and eighty-seven dollars as set forth in the Schedule hereto for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of the Colony, and for other purposes during the said year.
