ORDINANCE No. 2 OF 1950.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance.

[25th March, 1950.]

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Town Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed with the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Cap. 86.

Amendment of section 205 of the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section two hundred and five of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "two hundred thousand" in the fourth and fifth lines of the words "six hundred thousand".

Amendment of section 212 of the Principal Ordinance.

3. Section two hundred and twelve of the Principal Ordinance, as substituted by section three of the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance, 1936, is hereby amended by the substitution for the proviso to subsection (3) of the following proviso:—

"Provided that no such sums shall be borrowed without the consent of the Governor in Council, and the sums so borrowed shall not exceed at any one time the amount of loan authorised."
