**ORDINANCE No. 3 OF 1950.**

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Supreme Court of Judicature Ordinance. A.D. 1950.

[28th March, 1950.

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:--

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supreme Court of Judicature (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed and read as one with the Supreme Court of Judicature Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any amending Ordinance. Short title.

Amendment of Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance. No. 32 of 1936.

2. Section six of the Principal Ordinance, as repealed and replaced by section two of the Supreme Court of Judicature (Amendment) Ordinance, 1936, is hereby amended —

- (a) by the substitution for the words “not more than three” of the words “not more than four”; and
- (b) by the substitution for the words “the First and Second Puisne Judges” of the words “the First, Second and Third Puisne Judges”.

Amendment of section 8 of the Principal Ordinance.

3. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance as amended from time to time is hereby further amended —

- (a) by the substitution in subsection (1) for the words “five thousand three hundred”, and the words “twenty-five thousand four hundred and forty” of the words “six thousand eight hundred” and “thirty-two thousand six hundred and forty” respectively; and
- (b) by the insertion in subsection (2) after the seventh line thereof, of the words —  
“to the Third Puisne Judge a salary not exceeding fifteen hundred pounds;”.

Amendment of section 52 of the Principal Ordinance.

4. Section fifty-two of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

- (a) by the substitution for the words “one hundred dollars” of the words “two hundred and fifty dollars”; and
- (b) by the substitution for the symbol and figures “\$100” in the marginal note thereto, of the symbol and figures “\$250”.
