ORDINANCE No. 5 of 1950.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Pensions Ordinance, 1933, by preserving the rights of officers appointed to the service of the Government of Ceylon or the Government of Palestine prior to the fourth day of February, nineteen hundred and forty-eight, or the fifteenth day of May, nineteen hundred and forty-eight, respectively.

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title. No. 20 of 1933.

Amendment of regulation 2 of Schedule to the Principal Ordinance. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed with the Pensions Ordinance, 1933, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. The definition of the expression "Scheduled Government" in regulation 2 of the Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion therein after the words "these Regulations" of the words "and includes the Government of Ceylon in respect of any officer appointed to the service of that Government prior to the 4th February, 1948, and the Government of Palestine in respect of any officer appointed to that Government prior to the 15th May, 1948".
