ORDINANCE No. 6 OF 1950.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Co-Operative Societies Ordinance, 1948. A.D. 1950.

[25th March, 1950.

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Co-operative Societies (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be read and construed as one with the Co-operative Societies Ordinance, 1948, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title.

2. Section twenty-one of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of a colon for the full-stop at the end of the section and by the addition of the following proviso — Amend-
ment of
Section 21
of the
Principal
Ordinance.

“Provided that a pupil attending any school, may, notwithstanding the provisions of paragraphs (a) and (b) of this section, with the consent in writing of the Director of Education, be registered as a member of a society.”

3. Section twenty-four of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the word “Regulations” in paragraph (b) of the proviso thereto of the word “Rules”. Amend-

4. Section forty of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended — Amend-
ment of
Section 40
of the
Principal
Ordinance.

(a) by the insertion therein after the words “the society shall” of the following, “except for the purposes of winding-up, as hereinafter provided,”; and

(b) by the substitution for the words “sixteen and seventeen” occurring in the proviso thereto, of the words “sixteen, seventeen and forty-nine”.
