ORDINANCE No. 9 OF 1950.

A.D. 1950. — AN ORDINANCE to amend the Gambling Prevention Ordinance, (Chapter 95.)

[8th April, 1950.]

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Gambling Prevention (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed with the Gambling Prevention Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any amending Ordinance.

2. Section twenty-one of the Principal Ordinance as enacted by section two of the Gambling Prevention (Amendment) Ordinance, is hereby amended —

(a) by the substitution for the words "fifteen per centum" in subsection (4) of the words "ten per centum";

(b) by the substitution of a colon for the full stop at the end of subsection (4) and the addition thereto of the following proviso —

"Provided that the Governor in Council may by Order vary the percentage to be paid to the Sweepstakes (Charity) Committee under this subsection."; and

(c) by the addition of the following subsections —

"(5) An Order made under the proviso to the preceding subsection shall be laid before the Legislative Council.

(6) All allocations by the Club of percentages to be paid as prize money in connection with any sweepstake or lottery shall be subject to the approval of the Governor in Council".
