ORDINANCE No. 30 of 1950.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Criminal Law (Procedure) Ordinance.

[7th October, 1950.]

A.D. 1950.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Law (Procedure) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed and read as one with the Criminal Law (Procedure) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. The definition of the expression "Court of Appeal" in section two of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.

3. Sections one hundred and seventy-four to one hundred and seventy-seven inclusive of the Principal Ordinance are hereby repealed.
