ORDINANCE No. 32 of 1950.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pensions Ordinance, 1933, by providing for the pensions of officers with mixed service in Government and the Health Services.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment No. 2), Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed with the Pensions Ordinance, 1933, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Anything contained in any Ordinance to the contrary notwithstanding, the pension of any officer who has, in addition to his public service, served for any period with —

- (a) the Society for the Prevention and Treatment of Tuberculosis; or
- (b) the Infant Welfare and Maternity League; or
- (c) the Municipal Health Services of the Colony,

shall be computed and apportioned as if his service, other than his public service, had been wholly under a scheduled Government.
