ORDINANCE No. 34 of 1950.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Tax Ordinance, 1939.

[7th October, 1950.]

A.D. 1950. BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed and read as one with the Tax Ordinance, 1939, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby further amended by the insertion therein after section forty-two of the following new section —

“Special 42A. A special licence issued under the provisions of licences for section ninety-eight of the Intoxicating Liquor the sale of section Licencing Ordinance shall be an annual one, and the intoxicating liquor. duty shall be fifty dollars.”
