ORDINANCE No. 37 of 1950.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Mitchell Trust Ordinance, 1937, by extending the time for the submission of accounts by the Trustees; by making provision for notices to be given in the case of a vacancy occurring among the beneficiaries; and by increasing the benefits payable thereunder.

A.D. 1950. BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Mitchell Trust (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed and read as one with the Mitchell Trust Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance,

2. Subsection (1) of section five of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "the thirty-first day of January in each year" of the words "the thirty-first day of May in each year".

Amendment of section 5 (1) of the Principal Ordinance.

3. Section ten of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

Amendment of section 10 of the Principal Ordinance.

(a) by the insertion after the words "this Ordinance" of the words "or within one month of the occurrence of a vacancy under section thirteen or within such further time as the trustees may allow"; and

(b) by the insertion after the words "inviting applications" of the words and brackets "to be made on or before the date specified in the notices (which date shall be approved by the trustees for the purpose)".

4. Section twelve of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

Amendment of section 12 of the Principal Ordinance.

(a) by the substitution in subsection (1) for the words "one hundred and twenty dollars" occurring therein of the words "one hundred and eighty dollars"; and

(b) by the addition of the following subsection —
"(3) The Governor in Council may, by Order increase or reduce the sum payable under this section".
