ORDINANCE No. 48 of 1950.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Post and Telegraph Ordinance, Chapter 185, with respect to the grant of licences to instal, use or work amateur wireless stations.

[25th November, 1950].

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:— A.D. 1950.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Post and Telegraph (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed with the Post and Telegraph Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same. Short title.

2. Section sixty-one of the Principal Ordinance as enacted by section two of the Post and Telegraph Ordinance, 1935, is hereby amended by the addition of the following as a second proviso to subsection (1) — Amend-

“Provided also that licences to instal, use or work amateur wireless stations may be granted by the Postmaster General on payment of the prescribed fee and shall be subject to any regulations made under this section.”
