ORDINANCE No. 5 of 1951.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Cattle Stealing Prevention Ordinance with respect to the branding of cattle.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:— A.D. 1951.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Cattle Stealing Prevention (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, and shall be construed and read as one with the Cattle Stealing Prevention Ordinance, Short title.
hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Cap. 94.

Amendment of subsection (1) of section 8 of the Principal Ordinance. No. 39 of 1950.

2. Subsection (1) of section eight of the Principal Ordinance as substituted by section four of the Cattle Stealing Prevention (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, is hereby amended —

- (a) by the substitution of a full stop for the colon at the end of paragraph (b), and
- (b) by the repeal of the proviso thereto.
