## BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 8 of 1951.

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the supplies granted in the current session of the Legislative Council.

WHEREAS of the amount of twenty-four million two hundred and twenty-four thousand and eighteen dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of this Colony, and for other purposes, for the year commencing on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty one, the sum of one million eight hundred and thirty-one thousand seven hundred and sixteen dollars has been provided for by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue the year and other resources of the Colony of twenty-two million three hundred and ninety-two thousand three hundred and two dollars;

Be it, therefore, enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1951.

Financial Secretary and Treasurer to defray expenses of Civil Government.

2. The Financial Secretary and Treasurer shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay from the annual revenue of the year, commencing the first day of January nineteen hundred and fifty-one and other resources of the Colony a sum not exceeding in the aggregate twenty-two million three hundred and ninety-two thousand three hundred and two dollars as set forth in the Schedule hereto for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of the Colony, and for other purposes during the said year.
