BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 10 OF 1951.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Customs Duties Ordinance, 1935.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

A.D. 1951

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1951, and shall be construed and read as one with the Customs Duties Ordinance, 1935, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

No. 23 of 1935.

Amendment of section 18 of the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section eighteen of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

- (a) by the substitution for the words "date of importation thereof" in subsection (1) of the words "date of entry for use in the Colony";
- (b) by the insertion after the words "such goods shall be forfeited" in subsection (1) of the words "unless already consumed";
- (c) by the substitution for the words "The importer of any such goods" in subsection (2) of the words "Subject to the provisions of subsection (3) of this section, the importer of any such goods"; and
- (d) by the addition of the following sub-sections —
- "Regulations. (3) Where any such goods are of a consumable nature or may be expended or used within the period of three years as aforesaid, the Comptroller may, with the approval of the Governor in Council, make Regulations prescribing the method of dealing with and accounting for such goods, or for any other purposes in relation to such goods.
- (4) There may be annexed to any regulation made under the preceding subsection a penalty for the breach thereof not exceeding five hundred dollars."

Amendment of the Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance, No. 25 of 1944.

3. The Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance as substituted by section two of the Customs Duties (Amendment No. 2) (Consolidation of Schedules) Ordinance, 1944, is hereby further amended by the insertion therein after item 17 of the following new item —

17A. Aluminium sheets, plain or corrugated	2%	11%

Amendment of the Fourth Schedule to the Principal Ordinance.

4. The Fourth Schedule to the Principal Ordinance as substituted by section two of the Customs Duties (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1944, is hereby further amended by the insertion in item 1 after sub-item 36 of the following sub-item —

"36A. Gasolene of British Empire production when imported or cleared from a bonded warehouse for use as fuel for driving machinery for the purposes of any of the industries set out hereunder:—

Balata and rubber production.

Food production (including any drainage and irrigation incidental thereto).

Gold and diamond mining.

Woodcutting.

CUSTOMS DUTIES (AMENDMENT No. 2)

Provided that the Governor in Council may by Order add any industry to or remove any industry from the list of industries in this sub-item."
