ORDINANCE No. 20 OF 1951.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sugar Industry Special Funds Ordinance, 1947. A.D. 1951.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sugar Industry Special Funds (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, and shall be construed and read as one with the Sugar Industry Special Funds Ordinance, 1947, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title

2. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following subsection —

“(3) The Committee appointed under subsection (2) of this section shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal, may sue and be sued in all courts of justice and may hold land without the licence of the Governor in Council.”.
