ORDINANCE No. 25 OF 1951.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the New Amsterdam Town Council A.D. 1951.
Ordinance, 1949.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the Short title.
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the New Amsterdam Town No. 25 of
Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, and shall be construed 1949.
and read as one with the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance, 1949, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (2) of section eleven of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "His Majesty's Dominions (including therein British protectorates, protected states and mandated territories)" of the words "His Majesty's dominions (which expression shall be deemed to include any territory under His Majesty's protection or in which His Majesty has, for the time being jurisdiction)".

3. Section one hundred and twenty-three of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (2) of the following subsection —

"(2) The report shall forthwith be published in the *Gazette*."
