## BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 31 OF 1951.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Widows and Orphans Pension Ordinance.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with A.D. 1951 the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Widows and Orphans Short title.  
Pension (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, and shall be construed and read as one with the Widows and Orphans Pension Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same. Cap. 207.
