ORDINANCE No. 34 of 1951.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Matrimonial Causes (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Matrimonial Causes (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, and shall be construed and read as one with the Matrimonial Causes (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Section four of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "on the ground specified in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section nine of the Principal Ordinance as substituted by section two of this Ordinance" of the words "on the ground of malicious desertion".

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have had effect from the commencement of the Principal Ordinance.
