## BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 39 of 1951.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Constabulary Ordinance.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with A.D. 1951. the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—
