



## BRITISH **GUIANA**

ORDINANCE No. 44 of 1951

An Ordinance to continue in operation for a further period of one year the Sugar Duty Ordinance, 1942.

WHEREAS the Sugar Duty Ordinance, 1942, which was temporary in its duration and limited to expire on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-two, was continued in operation from year to year to the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-one;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient further to extend the operation of the said Ordinance:

BE IT, THEREFORE, enacted by the Governor of British A.D. 1951 Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sugar Duty (Con-Short title. tinuance) Ordinance, 1951.

2. The Sugar Duty Ordinance, 1942, shall continue in operation until and including the thirty-first day of December, nineteen ance until hundred and fifty-two.
