BRITISH GUIANA

ORDINANCE No. 44 of 1951

AN ORDINANCE to continue in operation for a further period of one year the Sugar Duty Ordinance, 1942.

WHEREAS the Sugar Duty Ordinance, 1942, which was temporary in its duration and limited to expire on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-two, was continued in operation from year to year to the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-one;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient further to extend the operation of the said Ordinance;

BE IT, THEREFORE, enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

A.D. 1951

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sugar Duty (Continuance) Ordinance, 1951.

Short title.

2. The Sugar Duty Ordinance, 1942, shall continue in operation until and including the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-two.

Continuance until 31st December, 1952, of Ordinance No. 11 of 1942.
