## BRITISH GUIANA

ORDINANCE No. 45 OF 1951.

An Ordinance further to amend the Tax Ordinance, 1939.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the A.D. 1951. advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows: -

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment Short title. No. 3) Ordinance, 1951, and shall be construed and read as one with the Tax Ordinance, 1939, hereinafter referred to as the No. 43 Principal Ordinance.
