## ORDINANCE No. 4 OF 1952.

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the supplies granted in the current session of the Legislative Council.

[8th March, 1952.]

WHEREAS of the amount of twenty-five million seven hundred and seventy-seven thousand and four hundred and sixty-five dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of this Colony, and for other purposes, for the year commencing on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-two, the sum of

two million six hundred and sixty-six thousand and one hundred and thirteen dollars has been provided for by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of the Colony of twentythree million one hundred and eleven thousand and three hundred and fifty-two dollars:

- Be it, therefore, enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, A.D. 1952. with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows: -
- Short title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1952.

Financial Secretary and Treasurer to defray Civil Government.

2. The Financial Secretary and Treasurer shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay from the annual revenue of the year, commencing the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fiftytwo, and other resources of the Colony a sum not exceeding in the expenses of aggregate twenty-three million one hundred and eleven thousand and three hundred and fifty-two dollars as set forth in the Schedule hereto for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of the Colony, and for other purposes during the said year.
