BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 8 of 1952.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Widows and Orphans Pension (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950.

[21st June, 1952.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

A.D. 1952

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Widows and Orphans Pension (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952, and shall be construed and read as one with the Widows and Orphans Pension (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section two of the Principal Ordinance, as amended by section two of the Widows and Orphans Pension (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1951, is hereby further amended by the addition of the following proviso thereto —

“Provided that where the transfer to the service of the Government of British Guiana is not to a pensionable office, but the officer after serving continuously in a non-pensionable office is appointed to a pensionable office, then, following the latter appointment, the Governor in Council may, in his discretion, by order direct that the officer be permitted to make the lump sum payment within such time as may be prescribed by the order.”

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the fifth day of August, nineteen hundred and fifty.
