## BRITISH GUIANA

ORDINANCE No. 10 of 1952.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Tax Ordinance, 1939.

[19th July, 1952].

A.D. 1952. BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the  
 ——— advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment)  
 Ordinance, 1952, and shall be construed and read as one with the  
 No. 43 of Tax Ordinance, 1939, hereinafter referred to as the Principal  
 1939. Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Amend- 2. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is hereby further  
 ment of amended by the insertion therein after item (29) of the following  
 section 8 of item —  
 the Prin- “(29A) Seaman’s Certificate of Nationality and  
 cipal Ordinance. Identity .. .. . 0.60.”

Commence- 3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into effect  
 ment. on the first day of March, nineteen hundred and fifty-two.
