BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 12 OF 1952.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) Ordinance.

[2nd August, 1952.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

A.D. 1952.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952, and shall be construed and read as one with the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

Cap 9.

2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby further amended by the insertion therein after section seventeen of the following section —

Insertion of new section 17A in the Principal Ordinance.

“Ex officio justices of the peace.

17A. Every district commissioner, assistant district commissioner and clerk of court for the time being shall *ex officio* be a justice of the peace for the Colony”.
