ORDINANCE No. 8 of 1953

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Teachers Pensions Ordinance to make provision for the payment of pensions to teachers in nursery schools, and with respect to the time within which certain teachers may exercise the option to take a reduced pension with a gratuity and to extend certain provisions relating to the rate of pension in the cases of certain deceased teachers.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

A.D. 1953

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Teachers Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1953, and shall be construed and read as one with the Teachers Pensions Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

2. Section two of the Principal Ordinance as amended by section two of the Teachers Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, is hereby further amended by the insertion between the words "elementary school" and the word "in" of the commas and words " , or a nursery school ,".

Amendment of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance. No. 7 of 1947.

3. Section three B of the Principal Ordinance as inserted by section two of the Teachers Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, is hereby amended by the insertion between the word "retirement" and the word "that" in subsection (5) of the words "or the thirty-first day of May, nineteen hundred and fifty-three, whichever is the later,".

Amendment of section 3B of the Principal Ordinance. No. 42 of 1951.

4. The provisions of the Principal Ordinance and of sections two to five inclusive of the Teachers Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, shall apply to every teacher whose name was in the Teachers Pension Register on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-three and who retired as a teacher or from the public service of the Colony on or after the first day of January, nineteen hundred and forty-four, and who died on or before the fifteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-one.
