ORDINANCE No. 8 of 1953

An Ordinance further to amend the Teachers Pensions Ordinance to make provision for the payment of pensions to teachers in nursery schools, and with respect to the time within which certain teachers may exercise the option to take a reduced pension with a gratuity and to extend certain provisions relating to the rate of pension in the cases of certain deceased teachers.
