ORDINANCE No. 13 of 1953.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Old Age Pensions Ordinance, 1944, by empowering the Governor in Council to fix the monthly income which an applicant may receive without being disqualified from receiving an old age pension.

[2nd May, 1953.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

A.D. 1953.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Old Age Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1953, and shall be construed and read as one with the Old Age Pensions Ordinance, 1944, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

(a) by the substitution for the words “the amounts prescribed in the subsection next following” in paragraph (d) of sub-section (1), of the words “such amount as may by Order be prescribed by the Governor in Council”;

(b) by the substitution for subsection (2) of the following —

“(2) Any Order made under this section may be varied from time to time.”

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-two.
