ORDINANCE No. 14 of 1953.

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the supplies granted in the current session of the Legislative Council.

WHEREAS OF the amount of Thirty-two million four hundred and seventy-five thousand seven hundred and fifty-five dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of this Colony, and for other purposes, for the year commencing on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-three, the sum of two million six hundred and thirty-seven thousand two hundred and twelve dollars has been provided for by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of the Colony of twenty-nine million eight hundred and thirty-eight thousand five hundred and forty-three dollars:

BE IT, THEREFORE, enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1953. Short Title.

9th May, 1953.

2. The Financial Secretary and Treasurer shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay from the annual revenue of the year, commencing the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-three, and other resources of the Colony a sum not exceeding in the aggregate twenty-nine million eight hundred and thirty-eight thousand five hundred and forty-three dollars as set forth in the Schedule hereto for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of the Colony, and for other purposes during the said year. Financial Secretary and Treasurer to defray expenses of Civil Government.
